

## Installing Software Updates on your MAC



### Updating your software

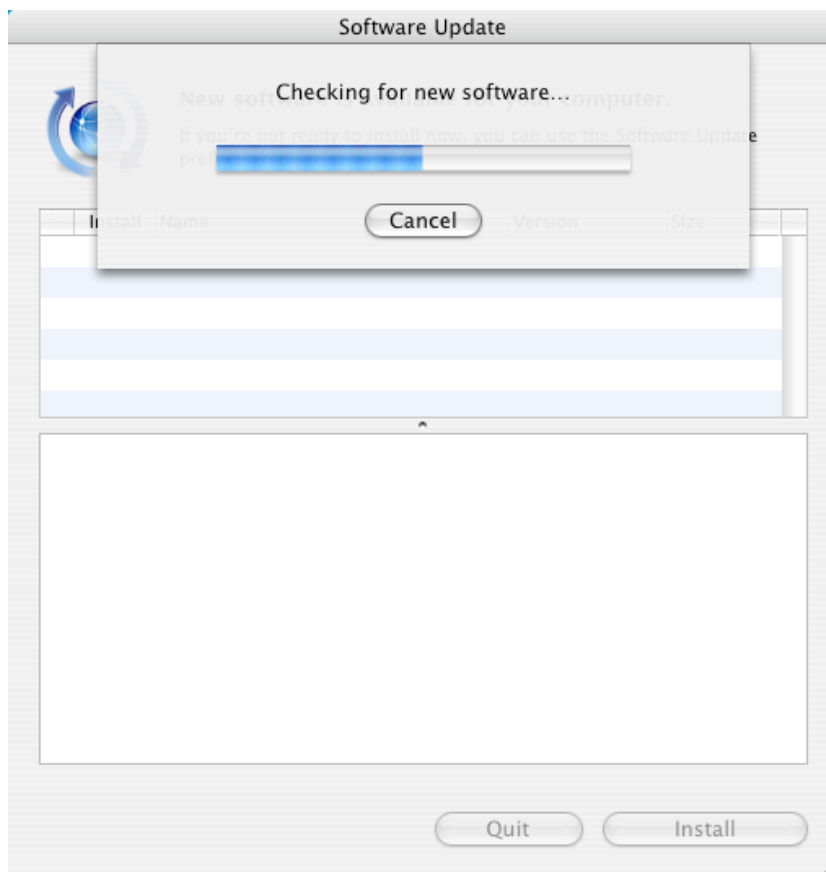
Periodically, Apple releases free updates to your computer's software. You can check for updates manually or set your computer to check for updates periodically.

You must have an Internet connection to receive software updates.

#### To check for updates manually:

1. Choose Apple menu > Software Update. The Software Update window opens. If there are any updates available, they appear in a list.
2. Click the checkbox to select the items you want to install, then click Install. Type an administrator name and password (the name and password you used when you first set up your computer).

When the updates complete, Software Update checks for updates again. It does this because some updates require that you have installed previous updates.
